

TCCOM Trash Recycling Program

Household Garbage Dumpsters (Closest to the entrance gate)

- If it is something you normally put in an indoor trash can (less recycle) it probably goes here. Household garbage DOES NOT mean ALL trash that comes out of your household.

Recycle -- Large Blue Bins (Right of Household Garbage Dumpsters)

- Cardboard (please flatten boxes)
- Glass jars and bottles
- Newspapers and inserts, magazines, catalogs
- Paper, Junk mail, phone books, etc.
- Plastic (milk jugs, bottles with necks only)

(If above items still contain food, they go in household garbage.)

Recycle -- Round Trash Cans

- Aluminum cans only (please crush cans)

Construction Debris Dumpster (Closest to Welcome building)

PAY AT OFFICE

- Construction Debris
- Unusual Trash like lawn chairs, furniture, etc.

TCCOM Trailer (Outside Storage, Lot 20)

PAY AT OFFICE

- Electronics, Appliances and Scrap Metal (to include lawn mowers with oil removed) only

Hazardous Waste

The following partial list are hazardous waste and must be disposed of outside of the Park:

- *Tires*
- *Aerosols*
- *Batteries*
- *Chemicals*
- *Leftover paint*
- *Oil*
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Anything with mercury or PCBs
